Dr Merle Friedman, December 15th, 1997

I can only say I chose not to know.

I chose my own comfort over the pain of knowing. I am so deeply sorry!

This privilege allows me to reach even further into my soul to express the remorse that I feel.

It impels me to continue to seek in my own small way to help repair the damage.
